

MARAMUREȘ AT A GLANCE Economic profile



The county has a Gross Domestic Product of 3.2B EUR (2018), with a GDP per capita of 7,8K EUR (2020), below the national and regional average.

Six companies are reaching above the 50M EUR turnover: ARAMIS INVEST SRL, EATON ELECTRO PRODUCȚIE SRL, UNIVERSAL ALLOY CORPORATION EUROPE SRL, AVIVA SRL, STEELCORP DISTRIBUTION SRL, WEIDMÜLLER INTERFACE ROMANIA SRL.

The research, development and high-tech sector averages to 1% of the county's economy, while a cumulated turnover of 51M EUR, while the industry and the trade sectors are the main contributors with 42% and 28%.

Rich industrial heritage in branches closely related to the exploitation of natural resources in the area: extractive and metallurgical industry, forestry and logging, wood processing and furniture production.

Positive Balance of Trade and low unemployment rate, with a very competitive average wage: 870 EUR/month compared to the national average of 1012 EUR/month (in 2021).

MARAMUREȘ AT A GLANCE Workforce



About two thirds of our county's population is in the working age. About a third of labour resources is involved in informal activities, especially agriculture, mainly in rural areas.

More than 10% of the county's population has pursued short or long-term work opportunities abroad, often in cultures conducive to professional advancement, including high-tech industries. This trend highlights the county's competitive advantage in terms of a skilled and capable local labour force.



99% of the registered companies in Maramureş are SMEs with less than 9 employees.



Commuting has amplified in recent years, especially around the municipality of Baia Mare, and involves over 15% of the workforce, having a positive contribution to the development of communities In partnership with the County Council we are developing a dual education campus aimed at training specialized work force for any investors.

BENEFITS Incentives

- 100% deduction for profits distributed by sources of development.
- Deduction from taxable profits equal to 100% of the value of investments made in smart specialization industrial parks.
- Exemption from building tax for buildings located in smart specialization industrial parks.
- Exemption from land tax for land located in smart specialization industrial parks.
- Tax exemption for profits invested in technology, computers, peripheral equipment, and software.
- Tax exemption for income earned by employees in the ITC and research & development fields.

Additional incentives that may be granted by the local public administration in accordance with the law.
